Project for Rehabilitation of Irrigation System for Six Villages in Akhaltsikhe Municipality

On February 8, 2018 at 13:00, the Grant Contract was signed by HE Ambassador Tadaharu Uehara and the Chairman of the Caucasus Institute for Peace, Democracy and Development (CIPDD) Mr. Gia Nodia. Under the project, six villages in Akhaltsikhe municipality will be provided with access to affordable, cost-efficient gravity flow irrigation (which will not require electricity or other energy to operate). The project will eventually contribute to livelihood improvement of the target rural communities. The project funding amount is USD 89,188.

Project for Construction of Rehabilitation Center for Persons with Disabilities in Mestia Municipality

On February 8, 2018 at 13:00, the Grant Contract was signed by HE Ambassador Tadaharu Uehara and the Board Director of the Together for Real Changes (TRC) – Ms. Nana Lomadze. Under the project, the first multifunctional Rehabilitation Center will be constructed in the region, which will serve approximately 150 beneficiaries of all ages per year. Among others, the project is expected to contribute to decreasing maternal and infant mortality, as well as provide rehabilitation support to persons with disability. The project funding amount is USD 86,271.

Project for ERW (Explosive Remnants of War) Clearance in Shida Kartli and Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti Regions.

On February 8, 2018 at 13:00, the Grant Contract was signed by HE Ambassador Tadaharu Uehara and the Programme Manager of the Halo Trust Representation in Georgia – Mr. Irakli Chitanava. Under the project, HALO Trust will complete clearance of areas, contaminated as a result of the Russo-Georgian war (which include villages Dvani and Dzevera in Shida Kartli region and Anaklia in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region). As a result of clearance works, unexploded remnants of war will be removed and the area will become safe for its residents. The project funding amount is USD USD 400 000.
