

Opening Ceremony of the Project for Provision of Ceramic Equipment for Three Social Care Centers in Tbilisi, Gori and Shavshvebi IDP Settlement by the Government of Japan within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects”

On October 28, 2015, the Opening Ceremony was held in Camillians Medical Center in Tbilisi concerning the Project for Provision of Ceramic Equipment for Three Social Care Centers in Tbilisi, Gori and Shavshvebi IDP Settlement, which has been implemented within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects” of the Government of Japan in cooperation with the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in Georgia. The Ceremony was attended by the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Georgia, H.E. Toshio Kaitani, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Poland to Georgia, H.E. Andrzej Cieszkowski, representatives of local government and members of related organizations.

This project was implemented by the Order of Regular Clerks Ministers to the Sick (Camillians) Georgian Branch. Under this project ceramic workshops were arranged in three social care centers in Tbilisi, Gori and Shavshvebi IDP settlement. These workshops will serve persons with disabilities and children and will help them broaden their physical abilities and gain professional skills. The grant amount for this project is 88,515 USD.
