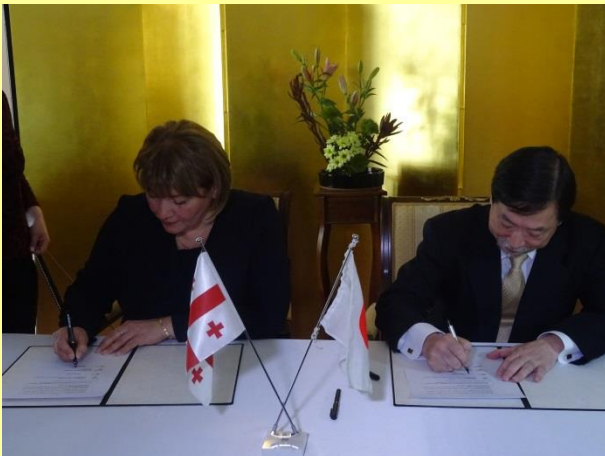


# Signing ceremony for three projects financed by the Government of Japan within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects”

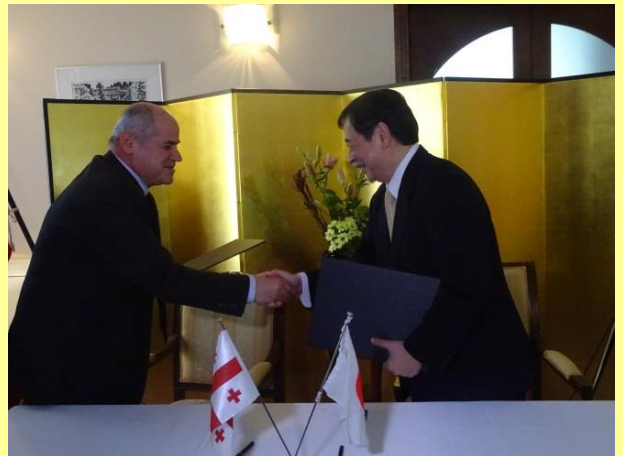
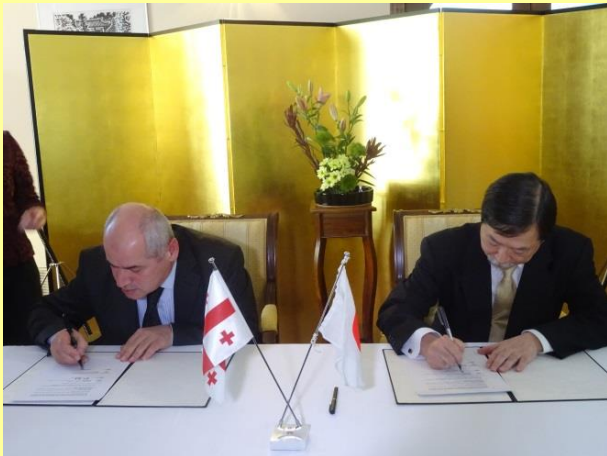
## Project for Rehabilitation of the Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence in Tbilisi

On February 23, 2017 the grant contract was signed by Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Georgia, Mr. Toshio Kaitani and Chairperson of Anti-Violence Network Of Georgia, Ms. Nato Shavlakadze for the Project for Rehabilitation of the Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence in Tbilisi.
