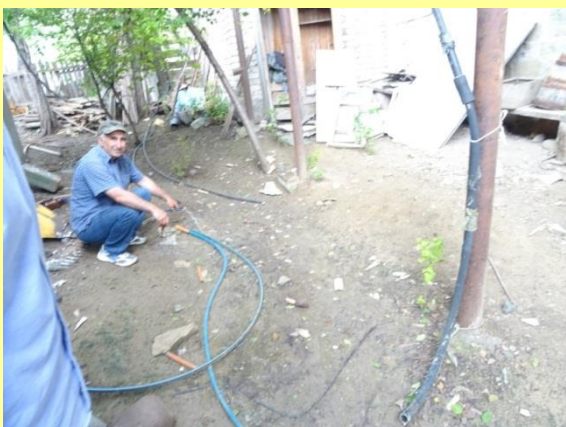

On July 10, 2017, the opening ceremony was held in Nakurdevi village concerning the Project for Construction of Water Supply System in Three Villages in Adigeni Municipality, which was implemented within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects” of the Government of Japan. The ceremony was attended by HE Mr. Toshio Kaitani, the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Georgia, Mr. Akaki Machutadze, Governor of Samtskhe-Javakheti region, Mr. Giorgi Kopadze, Member of Parliament of Georgia from Adigeni and Akhaltsikhe electoral district, Mr. Zakaria Endelaze, Head of Adigeni Municipality Administration, Ms. Eka Zhvania, Director of World Vision Georgia.

The project was implemented by World Vision Georgia. The Japanese grant for this project amounted to 85,904 USD. Under the project water supply system was constructed that will provide clean drinking water to about 800 people in Khevasheni, Nakurdevi and Untsa villages of Adigeni municipality. The project was co-financed by Adigeni municipality administration.
