

Opening Ceremony of the Project for Renovation of Kindergarten No.1 in Lagodekhi Municipality financed by the Government of Japan within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects”

On May 2, 2017, the opening ceremony was held in Lagodekhi concerning the Project for Renovation of Kindergarten No.1 in Lagodekhi Municipality, which was implemented within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects” of the Government of Japan. The Ceremony was attended by Mr. Toshio Kaitani, the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Georgia, Mr. Karlo Jamburia, Head of Lagodekhi Municipality Administration, Mr. Guram Macharashvili, Member of Parliament of Georgia, members of related organizations.

The project was implemented by NGO Georgian Civil Development Association. Under this project the municipal kindergarten was renovated which ensured renewed and comfortable environment for day-care and pre-school education for 150 children. The Japanese grant for this project amounted to 86,176 USD. Lagodekhi municipality administration co-financed the project and CARE International funded purchase of new furniture and equipment for the kindergarten.
