

The awarding ceremony of the project “Empowering Poor Communities and Micro-Entrepreneurs in the Georgia Tourism sector” in Akhmeta Municipality on April 6, 2017

On April 6, 2017 the awarding ceremony of the project “Empowering Poor Communities and Micro-Entrepreneurs in the Georgia Tourism sector” was held in Akhmeta Municipality. The Ceremony was attended by Mr. Tomonori Hasegawa, the Deputy Head of Mission of the Embassy of Japan in Georgia, representatives of the World Bank, representatives of local government and members of related organizations.

This is a project of 2.5 mln USD by World Bank and Japan Social Development Fund and implemented by Biological Farming Association “Elkana”. This time 28 persons received certificates during the event. 240 grants with the total amount of USD 379,387 were disbursed to people from Kakheti and Imereti. The project organized entrepreneurship trainings for 360 persons in both regions.
