

Opening Ceremony of the Project for Upgrading the Irrigation System for Agricultural Use in Akhalkalaki Municipality financed by the Government of Japan within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects”

On September 25, 2015 the opening ceremony for the Project for Upgrading the Irrigation System for Agricultural Use in Akhalkalaki Municipality was held in village Diliska, Akhalkalaki municipality, which has been implemented within the framework of “Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects” of the Government of Japan. The ceremony was attended by the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Georgia Mr. Toshio Kaitani, Gamgebeli of Akhalkalaki municipality, Mr. Eduard Agasaryan, Chairman of Sarkebuli of Akhalkalaki municipality, Mr. Hamlet Movsesyan, Member of Parliament of Georgia Mr. Samvel Petrosyan, local farmers and the representatives of related organizations.

The project was implemented in cooperation with Public Movement “Multinational Georgia”. Under this project modern mobile irrigation system was provided to about 100 local farmers in Akhalkalaki municipality. This has increased their productivity and competitiveness and will facilitate further introduction of new irrigation technology to the region. The grant amount for this project is 87,542 USD.
