

Opening Ceremony of the grant project on “Introduction of Clean Energy by Solar Electricity Generation System”

On July 30, 2016 – the Opening Ceremony of the Solar Electricity Generation System was held in Tbilisi International Airport.

The ceremony was attended by Mayor of Tbilisi H.E. Mr. David Narmania, Ambassador of Japan H.E. Mr. Toshio Kaitani, representatives from United Airports of Georgia, Tbilisi International Airport, Ilia State University, JICA and others.

Under this project, solar energy generation systems were installed at Tbilisi International Airport (power generation capacity 316 KW) and Ilia state University (power generation capacity 34 KW).

The project was implemented by the grant of 480,000,000 JPY (approximately 4.8 million USD) provided by the Government of Japan. Construction works were implemented by Japanese companies Itochu Corporation, Fuji Furukawa E&C CO. Ltd., Oriental Consultants Global and Crown Agents Japan together with Georgian partners.
